### July 2018

#### Substructure

July has seen the continued development of the field level slab, The Campus level swimming pool area wall has been completed. The RC works continue and making good progress assisted by the good weather.

#### Superstructure

The steel work has been installed from mid point towards college terrace bringing the structure from field level to the roof.

Initial pipework for the Swimming pool has commenced.

### August 2018

During August we should see the steel frame commencing south spanning over the swimming Pool Decking should also commence for the upper floors.

Fire protection to the steel frame will commence in the period.
